

BLOOM TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES EMERGENCY MEETING 01/16/06

The emergency meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Brian Randles, Vice Chairperson. Members present were Trustees Randles and Smith, and Fiscal Officer Carol Moore. Trustee David Petty was absent due to a family obligation. Anne Darling Cyphert, Administrator of Building/Zoning/Board Office was also present.

The purpose of the emergency meeting was to immediately address plumbing issues at the Greencastle Office Building that have caused the temporary shut down of all restroom facilities.

Terry Halderman of Freeland Plumbing attended the meeting due to the company being sub-contracted by M-E Building Consultants when the renovation project commenced. David Shy, also of Freeland Plumbing attended the meeting.

The trustees and plumbers viewed the crawl space where the plumbing problems were evident. The plumbers and the trustees determined the problem was caused by a back up from the building to the aeration system. Randy Solt, Road Department Acting Supervisor, was contacted by telephone and asked to bring the mini-hoe and pea gravel to the building the next morning to assist Freeland Plumbing in laying the new sewage drain pipe. A port-a-pot will be brought in while the restrooms are closed.

Motion by Smith, second by Randles to approve up to \$6,000 for the needed plumbing repairs at the Greencastle building. Motion Carried, 2-0.

Randles adjourned the meeting.
