

## BLOOM TWP. BOARD OF TRUSTEES MINUTES 02/26/20

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order by Jason Smith, Chair. Other members present were Carol Moore, Brian Randles, Fiscal Officer David Cyphert, department supervisors, and interested citizens. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and we paused for a moment of silence to remember our military serving around the world.

### **FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT: by David Cyphert, Fiscal Officer**

- Motion by Randles, second by Moore to receive and file the minutes of the Feb 12, 2020 meeting.  
Motion carried 3-0.
- Motion by Moore, second by Randles to approve payments of \$37,859.52 and charges in the amount of \$91,371.80.  
Motion carried 3-0.

### **ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: by Anne Darling-Cyphert, Administrator**

- Salem Church Road property: There is a 70+ acre plot on this road that is for sale. We have had several inquiries about this. Property owner had planned to put 3 houses to 1 acre. She informed them this is not allowed per our zoning resolution.
- Fairfield County Ohio Township Assoc. meeting, 4/11/2020: It is Bloom Township's turn to host. We will provide BBQ pork and more. She thanked Lt. Williams for making the fire station (552) available for use.
- Ohio Fire Chiefs Assoc.: Assessment testings for a new fire chief are done. In 2-3 weeks, we will get assessment results; township officials will study them and decide who we desire to interview.
- Memorial Day Parade: She encouraged the elected officials to participate in the parade. She will arrange for a trailer for them to ride on. All are very enthusiastic about the parade.
- The administrative office experienced standing water in the basement of the admin. office building.

### **FIRE DEPARTMENT: by Lt. Thomas Williams**

1. Pickaway County contract (Madison Twp.) has been sent to them.
2. Motion by Moore, second by Randles to approve to pay Target Solutions bill February 2020, \$3,629.00. Motion carried 3-0.

### **ROAD DEPARTMENT: by Steve Green, Supervisor**

- Road Department is currently working on: tree work along the right of ways, litter pickup in the right of ways, and getting parts and maintenance done on tractors for the upcoming mowing season.
- We have gone through approximately 320 tons of salt and just restocked the salt barn with another 188 tons. We should have approximately 500 tons of salt left that we have on contract to order for 2019/2020.
